

BOTOX CLINIC

PRE-OP

All patients must go through pre-op prior to the Botox procedure. Pre-op is intended to give the anesthesiologist a chance to learn about your child's medical history and about any risks for sedation and to answer your questions. Pre-op appointments are preferred to be scheduled before the procedure on a different day. Pre-Op appointments can be scheduled 1-2 weeks before the procedure. The Pre-Op process will take 1 ½ to 2 hours to complete. Please schedule this appointment by calling 918-494-7430, Option #1.

If you live a long distance from Tulsa, special arrangements can be made to have your Pre-op appointment on the same day as the Botox procedure. In this case, please call the number above to arrange an appointment that suits your needs.

Bring patient's insurance card and a list of all medications, milligram or milliliter, and dosing schedule to the pre-op appointment.

Please check in at the Main Admitting desk in the Saint Francis Children's Hospital, Level A, and you will be directed to the appropriate location. The Children's Hospital is located on the north side of Saint Francis Hospital—you can park in the north parking garage.

PROCEDURE

The Botox Clinic begins at 2:00 pm. **Patients are asked to arrive 2 hours prior to the procedure, around 12:00 pm, to begin preparation for sedation and Botox injections.**

The Botox procedure will be done in the OPAD unit in Saint Francis Children's Hospital, Level 1.

Parent/Guardian will be allowed to remain with patient before and after the procedure, but will not be permitted in the room during the actual procedure.

NPO

Patient needs to stop all solid food and non-clear liquids (ie. milk) by 8:00 am, may continue clear liquids until 10:00 am, and then must be nothing by mouth after 10:00 am. which includes chewing gum, candy and mints.
